

Barbera Reserve 2015

Barbera is an Italian varietal grown mostly in Piedmont and the southwest area of Lombardy, where it accounts for 50% of the plantings. Half of our Barbera grapes are planted on a steep south facing slope while the balance is near a creek running through the vineyard. The combination of hillside stress and rich bottomland grapes is ideal. This wine is rich with aromas of wild strawberry, dark berry, and vanilla-chai spice. Extended oak aging mingles the berry aromas, balances the acidity, and adds a soft mocha finish. Go Italian and enjoy it with your favorite pasta dishes!
