Malbec Reserve 2014

Malbec is grown world wide and has proven to grow especially well in Paso Robles! It is one of the six varieties of Bordeaux wines, the most planted grape in Argentina, and widely used in Cahors, France. We got exceptional color depth in this wine and a ton of dark fruit on the nose along with violets, blackberry jam, and anise. The mouth is lush and full with ample tannins, followed by a lingering finish of baking spices and cinnamon toast from the extended oak ageing. Enjoy it now but the wine will age superbly for five to ten years too. Cheers!
