Pinot Noir Reserve Whale Rock 2013

Pinot Noir from this cool, CCOF-certified organic vineyard on the Westside of Paso Robles creates a lush wine with a ruby, garnet color. The vineyard name stems from the large amount of whale fossils found in the field. This wine is juicy and has aromas of crushed cherries, dried cranberries, cola, with underlying earth tones. There are ample, but polished tannins to frame the fruit and lengthen the finish. Selected barrels were carefully chosen to produce this delicious wine with weight on the palate. Pair with baked ham, smoked turkey, or mushroom ravioli. Cheers!
